SUBJECT: Voluntary Entry on Extended Active Duty (EAD)

TO: Air Force Reservists Concerned

- 1. Headquarters United States Air Force has authorized voluntary extended active duty of qualified members of the Air Force Reserve to serve with the recently mobilized Air National Guard and Air Force Reserve units. A preliminary screening of our files indicates that you may qualify for assignment to one of these units.
- 2. This special volunteer program will subject you to immediate extended active duty. Your initial assignment would be to one of the mobilized units. You will serve for the duration of the active federal military service required of that unit unless sooner relieved by competent authority, but no later than 25 January 1970. You may also be subject to reassignment to fill other active duty requirements after initially being ordered to extended active duty. However, this too would be no longer than 25 January 1970.
- 3. If you desire extended active duty under this program, immediately advise this Center, Attention: RPCR-II, by telegram, airmail letter, or telephone. Collect telephone calls or telegrams cannot be accepted. The telephone number is 303-825-1161, extension 318. Application forms will be forwarded upon request. Upon receipt of your signed application, your record will be reviewed by the Air Reserve Personnel Center EAD Board. If you are selected by the board, you will receive additional instructions.
