#### CONFERENCE ADMISSION

Admission to the conference will be by invitation only. At the time of registration, identification badges will be issued for admission to the auditorium during the conference. Seating limitation and the nature of the conference make it impossible for us to admit wives or guests of invitees.

#### ADMISSION TO THE CENTER

For those arriving at the Center by private cars, you may enter at either front gate where you will be waved through. Proceed directly towards Building 1 where NASA security guards will direct you to parking facilities. To insure your arriving on time, please allow an extra 15 minutes because of the normal heavy morning traffic to the Center.

#### LUNCHEON

Luncheon will be available to all conference attendees in the Center's cafeteria from 12:30 to 2:00 p.m. the two days of the conference.

#### LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

The Center cannot conveniently accommodate the parking of cars for all attendees; therefore, NASA transportation will be provided to and from the Center and the motels designated on the enclosed map.

For your information, courtesy cars are provided by some of the motels to and from the Houston International Airport.

#### MESSAGE CENTER
