SUBJ: Space Shuttle Crew Exercise Requirement			

Although the Directorate position at this time is not to require crew exercise for medical reasons on missions shorter than 14 days, I believe it is important that we begin to work provisions for exercise equipment onboard the Orbiter for optional crew use. Therefore, as a baseline I am directing you to consider an instrumented isokinetic exerciser, which is being developed jointly by you and DB under contract as part of an overall exercise system.

I want to personally review any problems or alterations to this baseline.
