SUBJECT: Release of Apollo XIV crew and quarantine support personnel

Upon completion of a comprehensive review of pertinent medical data and in view of the fact that no additional medical examinations are planned beyond the morning of February 26, 1971, I plan to release the Apollo XIV crew and Crew Reception Area support personnel from quarantine at a convenient hour. Although the twenty-one day isolation period expires at 0731, February 27, 1971, I am recommending that all quarantined personnel be released at 1700 hours, February 26, 1971.

This release time is subject to concurrence by your office and upon the approval of the Interagency Committee on Back Contamination of the release document, providing no new medical findings are in evidence in the interim between release approval and actual crew and personnel exit.
