It was moved and seconded that since the Quarantine program as conducted for the Apollo Lunar program was established only to protect terrestrial life from any possible hazard from back contamination; and since the evidence presented to the Interagency Committee on Back Contamination demonstrates:

- a. the incompatibility of geochemical findings with the existence of conventional life forms on the moon, and
- b. the complete absence of evidence, or hint, of hazard in the biotests conducted on samples from Apollo 11 and 12, and
- c. the evidence that the samples were representative of the various types of terrain, both surface and subsurface, mare and highland,

the Committee hereby recommends the termination of the Apollo Lunar Quarantine program.
