



Recommendation - The Rightly or wrongly there is going to be a major trial of ambulatory analysis & if it ~~to~~ ^{to working} comes close, there will be considerable use. There will be trial sales this year.

Technical - The heart of the system is the analysis unit which, to work properly must have many of the features of the best existing units. A fatal mistake would be to try to 'do everything' rather one must detect everything but leave the complex analyses to the expert eg. rate / RR₂ variation & for SVE, size / configuration for VPB₂ ^{etc.} ST depression etc.

At this point I had some recommendations which we discussed at bhst. which were to add a simple on line analyzer to your existing unit and a good report generator & a simple inexpensive Holter playback / display.

After seeing the Datamedix unit everything else pales into insignificance. They appear to have added an advanced Holter unit to a miniature version of the best on line system available. I want They have a digital 2 channel ^{Holter} ^{tape} system & soon time (how many years did Shu tell you he could do such a system, how many times did Ray tell me it was crazy?). They have a phone modem for data transmission and in short just about everything one would want in this phase of recording.
