Dear Sir:

The Civil Air Patrol needs you to work with one of its units in your state on a point-gaining basis. The CAP has a threefold mission: to conduct search and rescue operations for the Air Force; to aid in civil defense and civil disasters such as floods, hurricanes, and the like; and to conduct an aerospace education program for its 38,000 senior members and 47,000 cadets. (Senior CAP members are 18 or older while cadets range from 13 to 21.)

You are needed to help perform all these missions. The jobs available embrace a variety of tasks such as teaching subjects in the aerospace education program, administering CAP units, publicizing the CAP before civic groups, and supervising the activities of other Reservists. In short, the jobs you can do are virtually unlimited.

The jobs are challenging and rewarding. Further, with more than 2,300 CAP units in the 50 states, District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico, you can probably gain points close to home. You will get a point for two to four consecutive hours of work. Every Reservist in the program will receive an Officer Effectiveness Report so your efforts will be recognized in your selection folder at promotion time.

We expect to offer short tours of active duty to Reservists participating in the program on a year-round basis. These tours will be for 7 to 15 days and involve such activities as administering aerospace education workshops at various colleges, managing flying encampments where some 400 cadets will learn to fly, staffing a cadet leadership school, and helping to conduct summer encampments for CAP wings.
