Subject: TV Presentation on Space Medicine

On 2 December 1960, I met Mr. Benjamin at the WPIX Studios, Daily News Building, in New York. We discussed the general orientation of the program and decided he would continue to play the role of the intelligent layman and ask the leading questions. The program will be beamed live on open TV (WPIX) in New York City at 1430, 3 January 1960, and then the kinescope made of that program may be used throughout the country. We may have a copy for USAF use.

The program layout will include the following. A review of space equivalent altitudes, emphasis on: oxygen, pressure, temperatures, radiation, acceleration, guidance monitoring.

Mr. Benjamin has requested that I arrive in New York the afternoon of the 2d to review the training aids and then have a dry run the AM of the 3d.
