

Dr. Allan H. Brown, Chairman of the National Academy of Sciences Space Science Board Committee to review the NAS Quarantine recommendations, stated that the Committee met today at the Manned Spacecraft Center. They heard a presentation of the crew and lunar sample data from Apollos XI and XII given by the MSC medical and scientific staff. There was considerable discussion of the results and their implications concerning further quarantine activity. The Committee will complete a report to the Space Science Board, who will consider it and make a recommendation to the NASA Administrator by 1 March. He will consider this report along with the recommendations from other advisory bodies.
