U.S. - USSR EDITORIAL BOARD

The fourth meeting of the Joint United States-USSR Editorial Board for the preparation and publication of a review of space biology and medicine convenes May 1 in Washington, D.C., for a four-day session.

The joint review of research in space biology and medicine is being carried forward under an Oct. 8, 1965

Memorandum of Understanding between the National Aeronautics and Space Administration and the USSR Academy of Sciences.

The agreement provides for a joint editorial board and for full cooperation by both sides in the preparation of materials available in the two countries, selection of authors and publication of their work.

Presiding at the meeting will be the Board Co-Chairman, Professor Melvin Calvin, University of California and Professor Oleg G. Gazenko, Director, Institute of Medical Biological Problems, Soviet Ministry of Health.

The other Soviet representatives are Nikolay N. Gurovskiy,
Ministry of Health, Pavel V. Simonov, Institute of High
Nervous Activity and Neurophysiology, Elenora F. Panchenkov,
Institute of Applied Mathematics, and Pavel V. Vasilyev,
Institute of Medical Biological Problems. U.S. Board members
include Dr. Loren D. Carlson, University of California at
Davis; Dr. Robert W. Krauss, University of Maryland; Dr. Wolf
Vishniac, University of Rochester; Dr. John P. Marbarger,
University of Chicago; Dr. Orr E. Reynolds, American Physiological Society and Gen. John Talbot, USAFE, Weisbaden, Germany.

The third meeting of the Joint Editorial Board was held in Moscow last September.
