Dr. Weber, VA-Long Beach, in conjunction with Drs. Thornton and Wallace, will be running a program on 40 hypertensive patients during mid-July or early August. We have promised to back this program with a minimum of five Pressurometer II's plus accessories.

They would like to start the program on July 24th. However, for this to take place they must take the patients off drugs for at least two weeks ahead. We must, therefore, confirm to Dr. Weber by July 1st that we can provide the equipment by July 24th.

VA-Long Beach is currently on order and is ordering a 680, a 671, and a 660A. This additional order should be in by the 22nd. We should look into the possibility of completing the order to VA-Long Beach by July 24th so that at least part of the equipment they use will be VA-owned.

During the week of July 24th, they will also need a Model 1979. This unit should be available for delivery by July 24th. We are providing Dr. Thornton. VA-Long Beach will probably need a Model 1979 for their own use but this will not be available until, probably, the end of the year.

By July 1st, please let me know by July 1st on top of the Pressurometer situation and let me know of the feasibility of supplying all the equipment.
