EFFECT OF HIGH "G" STRESS ON ASTRONAUT NO. "1", APOLLO "13"
DURING REENTRY

April 17, 1970, 12:44 PM to 1:08 PM.

This chart shows the effect on the HEART, VITALITY and STOMACH, of Astronaut No. 1, Apollo "13", caused by the rapid slowing down during reentry, resulting in the HIGH "G" stress, and later due to the "JERK" when the drogue shutes opened.

The exact time within seconds is shown so as to facilitate correlation with Telemetry data.
