- B. Full Name, two highest academic degrees, primary institutional affiliation, and current contact information, including current e-mail addresses FOR EACH AUTHOR.
- C. Name, city, state and country of the institution(s) to which the work is to be attributed.

Approximately 60 days before scheduled publication you will receive an e-mail from the printer giving you internet

access to your PDF galley proof. You will have only a few days to proof-read the file and provide corrections.
