- 1. The SPT reported the 7th major urine spill and will discontinue use of the Skylab urine system for the remaining 5 days of the SMEAT test. The system will be utilized again only in the event new bags are obtained prior to test completion.
- 2. The oral temperature probe appears to be reading low, indicating the subject's temperature after 40 minutes of exercise 2 degrees lower than the start. Post-test calibration of the probe will be conducted; also, the oral temperature procedure will be discussed with the crew for possible revision.
