

The weight losses noted were 2 and 3/4 lbs for Scott; 5 lbs for Irwin; and 3 lbs for Worden. In the first 21 hours following recovery, Scott regained 1 lb; Irwin regained 5 lbs; and Worden regained 2 lbs.

The crew is in good general condition. However, their performance level has not returned to the preflight baseline levels noted on exercise tolerance and lower body negative pressure. This has been seen on earlier missions prior to the 50 hour period post-recovery. We plan to conduct additional examinations tomorrow.

Commander Scott developed hemorrhages under 3 fingernails on his right hand and 1 on his left hand due to the work done with the tightly fitted suit gloves. These were not incapacitating and he was able to conduct the remaining 2 EVA's.
