Here's what's happening in the world of SMEAT.

- 1. Chamber build-up has run into problems. We had sandwiched our training in between chamber build-up and medical experiment installation. That time is nonexistent now. Our current approach is to get the facility with the experiments ready, and let us have it for 19 working days for training. This doesn't appear possible without a 3-week schedule slip.
