In answer to subject request Del Mar Engineering Laboratories has taken the following action to comply with this request.


- (1) We have sent certain Laboratory Test Equipment, which is used for quality control of our products, to their manufacturer or service organization for certification. This action was directed in order to comply with Section 2 of your request. This action will make available working gages and standards of known accuracy to Del Mar Engineering Laboratories.
- (2) Receipt of this certification from the instrument manufacturer or service organization is directed to comply with Section 3 of your form.
- (3) We consider the action requested in Section 5 as a phase of the general action requested under Section 2.
- (4) Action requested in Section 101 which specified need for a "Control System or Specification for Control for Test Equipment" is being prepared by our Engineering Department. This specification for control of equipment will be available for your approval on October 17, 1957, and prescribes manner in which Test Equipment will be identified, calibrated and recalibrated. This action complies with Section 103 as part of Section 101, as this forms a phase of the master control of test equipment.
