I. Significant Accomplishments - All scheduled DTO's were completed as planned. A special conference is being held with the crew at 0900 today to discuss the IMSS problems.

A. Hardware

1. The SPT reported the 7th major urine spill and will discontinue use of the Skylab urine system for the remaining 5 days of the SMEAT test. The system will be utilized again only in the event new bags are obtained prior to test completion.


2. The oral temperature probe appears to be reading low, indicating the subject's temperature after 40 minutes of exercise 2 degrees lower than the start. Post-test calibration of the probe will be conducted; also, the oral temperature procedure will be discussed with the crew for possible revision.
